Regular Business

Jeff:

- Got 320L repaired. Have been cleaning. Did portion of the Deaver where Leonhardt had complained about some seepage. Board discussed. Drainage discussed. In depth discussion.
- Rick: Joel Udem called him. Joel asked why some people get water after a certain amount of time and he gets shut off. Rick discussed issue with the Board. Discussion on date when water came out of the system. Irrigation is over when Shoshone pulls water from the top end. Deaver starts draining their system. It may take longer to drain out of

some laterals, but the District doesn't leave or make arrangement for some landowners to be able to irrigate longer. Discussion on water in and out date.

- Rick asked if the District was on winter hours. Jeff stated we were on 4 10's. Board discussed.
- Moved up to start work on 196F. Just got approval. Discussion on all aspects of this lateral. Will be backfilling old lateral and digging out structures.
- Crew finished pumping out pipelines. Have to pump out first chute on the Deaver. This is the chute that the USBR wants the floor redone on.
- Discussion on a cleaning issue and water delivery.
- Discussion on pooling water.
- Board had in depth discussion on all aspects of the irrigation season.
- D56-1, the steel pipe on the other side of the highway. Discussion had been on rolling the pipe over, now is the time because it is rusted through. Board discussed. This is below D56-1 chute that we just put into pipe. Board needs to review and decide what they would like to do. Replaced the ones on the end that were under ground a several years ago as they were completely rotted out.
- Tyler discussion on winter hours. Discussion on efficiency.
